SAN FRANCISCO, (June 1, 2017) – As part of the 21st annual PlayGround Festival of New Works now entering its fourth week, PlayGround presents the world premiere of Ignacio Zulueta’s immigration drama, KANO + ABE: A DALY CITY BIBLE STORY, continuing through June 18 performed in rotating repertory with Robin Lynn Rodriguez’s HEDGE, at PlayGround’s new San Francisco home, Potrero Stage: PlayGround Center for New Plays. Directed by Colin Johnson, the cast features Jed Parsario, Melvign Badiola, Carlos Aguirre, and Jasmine Osborne. Individual tickets are \$30-\$45. KANO + ABE: A DALY CITY BIBLE STORY takes an unflinching look at the human toll of America's wildly variable immigration attitudes and policies through the story of a soldier on the run who enters the shadow world of his undocumented brother. Abe, the good son, has returned from a tour of duty in Afghanistan. Kano, the prodigal, is conniving his way toward the undocumented American Dream. KANO + ABE is a story of sibling rivalry, undocumented immigration, and some good old fashioned murder.

Ignacio Zulueta (Playwright) was born in Manila, studied in Providence, and writes in Oakland. His plays have been seen and heard throughout the Bay Area, as well as in Ashland, New York, Minneapolis, and on KUSF 90.3FM and KPFA 94.1FM. He’s an alumnus of the AlterLAB at AlterTheatre and NewWorks

Incubator at Asian-American Theatre Company. Ignacio has written sketch comedy for Battlestache Studios and does radioplays and live foley for 915 Cayuga – a live radio style variety show. He is the lead writer for the multi-acre site-specific event *Matthew Briar and The Age of Resurrection* at San Jose's History Park. Ignacio is the recipient of a PlayGround Emerging Playwright Award and PlayGround Fellowship for his short and full-length plays.

PlayGround, the Bay Area's leading playwright incubator, provides unique development opportunities for the Bay Area's best new playwrights, including the monthly Monday Night PlayGround staged reading series, PlayGround Festival of New Works, Best of PlayGround, full-length play commissions and support for the production of new plays by local playwrights through the New Play Production Fund and, PlayGround's newest initiative, Potrero Stage: The PlayGround Center for New Plays. To date, PlayGround has supported more than 200 local playwrights in the development and staging of over 850 original short plays and 71 new full-length plays, including more than 22 that have since premiered in the Bay Area and around the country. PlayGround alumni have gone on to win local, national and international honors for their short and full-length work, including recognition at the O'Neill National Playwrights Conference, Humana Festival, Sundance Festival, the Lark, Bay Area Playwrights Festival, and New York International Fringe Festival, among others.
